Formerly known as our *Faith & Service Internship*, the Downtown Chapel offers a post-graduate opportunity for young adults to explore their faith by working in a community experiencing a variety of poverty issues. The position is designed to support the Fellow's future aspirations with a year-long experience of personal, professional, and spiritual formation.

Fellowship Details:

- Full-time, 12-month position (beginning August 11, 2010).
- Compensated with a living-wage salary, and benefits.
- Primary responsibility is directing *Downtown Chapel Connects*, an immersion program for local university and high school students interested in exploring the connection between faith and service, learning about homelessness, and our ministry of presence.
- Responsibilities also include staffing all of our community programs, light casework, relationship building, and community outreach.
- Opportunities to develop new programs that address both immediate needs and systemic change.
- Gain supervisory experience by overseeing community volunteers.
- As a member of the Pastoral Team serving the parish community, there are opportunities for involvement with liturgies and the faith education of the parish.
- Fellows attend Staff Retreats, and are encouraged to have a Spiritual Director and submit quarterly reflections about their fellowship experience.
